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1 Q How about Brother Collins?

2 A He was the principal at St. Laurence, I believe, my
3 first year there, 1972, 1973, because then Brother
4 Manning took over the second year.

5 Q On Page 2 of these minutes, you are identified in the
6 16th entry, and the rest of them are redacted.

7 It indicates that you were to have no contact with
8 Rice, Leo, or Laurence--

9 A Right.

10 Q And tell us about the circumstances for that.

11 A That's when I left St. Laurence when there was a
12 complaint from some parent, and I'm not-- I remember the
13 situation. After breakfast, Brother Manning, who was
14 the principal, called me in to talk, and he said there
15 had been complaints and basically told me I was going to
16 have to leave at that time.

17 He recommended that I-- let's see, how-- he said
18 that I should go get a job and get married. That was
19 his own personal recommendation.

20 I lived on the outside and worked at a travel
21 agency owned by a parent of St. Laurence for that time
22 until August, I believe, late August, so that would be
23 from January to August. That's what that was referring
24 to.

25 Q So there was a blowup, Brother Manning was confronted in
